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MATS, Musical Acumen Testing System

MATS is an Online Testing System for Indian music – Carnatic Edition which will assess and awards Graded Certification based on BEEJ's learning program AIM, Accelerated Indian Music.

The OTS comprises a set of *Objectives Based Multiple Choice Questions* in multimedia format such

- Answer to regular questions in Text format **(OR)**
- Listening to an AV Clip and select from the answer choices **(OR)**
- Record as an AV Clip for any given practical exercise

There are 9 Graded Certifications to complete the AIM Program.

The exams for the first 8 Grades from Level **Kalpa** to **Antara** are conducted through MATS.

The broad classification of MATS testing components for all the levels of Certification is ***Applied Theory, Aural Comprehension & Practical – I & II***

The MATS is a timed assessment and the duration split for each component is –

This component of Testing focusses on the various applications of Music Theory as a performing art.

Questions in *Applied Theory* will be on the following topics:

- **Types of Vocal Renditions in Carnatic Music**
- **The Scheme of Ragas in Carnatic – I** : The eight varieties of Janya Ragas
- **Types of Carnatic Compositions – I** : Understanding the different Segments of a Composition
- **Vageyakara – I** : Important Composers and the Mudras in their Compositions

AURAL | Prajnya**Weightage : 25%**

This component of Testing assesses the core musical understanding of a student through listening.

Questions in *Aural* will be on the following topics on various *Multimedia Testing Formats*

- **Sruthi Prajnya (Melodic Component)**
 - o Raga Identification in various formats (Aro / Ava; Phrases or Nuances ; Part of a composition)
 - **Non Vivadhi Melakartha Ragas** : 18 (Including Prati Madhyama Ragas)
 - **Janya Ragas**
 - o **Understanding Gamaka – II** (Recognizing the Simple Spuritas & Yugma Prayogas in Swara Prasthara)
- **Laya Prajnya (Rhythmic Component)**
 - o Understanding **Musical Timing** : Exercises on **Response to Change in Tempo**
 - o Understanding **Chatustambha Pravartini – I** : Yati & Karvai in any Given Musical Pattern / Phrase
 - o **Suladi Sapta Talas & Common Talas in Carnatic Music**

Sahitya Prajnya (Composition Aesthetics)

- o Understanding **Chandas – I**

PRACTICALS | Pradarshana**Weightage : 50%**

This is the main component of Testing that assesses the Real Time Rendition : Musical Quotient (RTR - MQ)

Questions in *Practical* will be on the following topics on various *Multimedia Answering Formats*

Proficiency Component (Quantitative)

- o **Voice Culture – II** : Swara Kriya on different Sthayi, Swara Sthana & Akara
- o Arohanam & Avarohanam with the associated Gamaka for **25 - 30** Ragas from Beej's **Raga Index Table**
- o Render minimum 2 Alankaras in different Kala, Sthayi & Tala in the **Sama Sampoorana / UKV Janya Ragas**
- o Render Akaram for any 2 **Swara Pratimana** (One in a given Raga & another of their own choice) with Gamaka.

Performance Component (Qualitative)

- o **10 - 15 minutes** recital of short simple musical compositions (including Lakshana / Lakshya Gitams)
 - Any 1 Adi Tala Varnam in Eka / Madhyama Kala from the given list of Varnams
 - Simple Compositions of Sri Thyagara & Sri Muddu Swami Dikshita in **Adi & Rupaka Tala**
 - Any short musical Composition (Thirupugazh/ Thevaram / Devaranama/ Bhajan)
